Discipleship 1

Which Components and Processes Characterize a Disciple?

<u>Admit</u> that you are a sinner (transgressor to God's will and law), and that only the Lord Jesus Christ can save you from God's punishment.

Romans 3:23	for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God
Romans 6:23	For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is <u>eternal life in Christ Jesus</u> our Lord.
John 14:6	<u>Jesus</u> answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except
	through me."
Acts 4:12	Salvation is found in no one else [than Jesus], for there is no other name under heaven given
	to men by which we must be saved.
1 John 1:8-9	If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we <u>confess</u>
	our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all
	unrighteousness.

<u>Believe</u> that Jesus Christ died on the cross and shed his own blood to pay the penalty (price) for your sins (offences against God), and that Jesus conquered death, rose from the grave and is alive today.

John 3:16	For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever <u>believes</u> in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
Romans 10:9-10	That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord", and believe in your heart that God
	raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are
	justified, and it is with your mouth that you <u>confess</u> and are saved.
John 5:24	I [Jesus] tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who has sent me has
	eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.
John 3:36	Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for
	God's wrath remains on him.
Titus 2:14	God and Saviour, Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness
1 Corinthians 6:20	You are not your own; you were bought at a price.

Repent. Be willing to turn yourself away from sin (evil) and to turn toward God (good) in faith.

Acts 17:30	In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now he commands all people everywhere to

<u>Pray</u> to God in faith that he by grace will save you; submitting yourself to God by <u>surrendering your life</u> (self-centered ambition...) and personally inviting Jesus to be the leader to all areas of your life.

1 John 4:15	If anyone acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in him and he in God.
Romans 10:13	Everyone who <u>calls</u> on the name of the Lord will be saved.
Ephesians 2:8-9	For it is by grace you have been saved, - and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God -
	not by works, so that no one can boast. (John 6:28-29)
Revelation 3:20	"Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I
	will come in and eat with him, and he with me." (John 10.7.9)

1 Peter 5:5-6 God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble. Humble yourselves, therefore, under

God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. (James 4:10)

Romans 6:12-14 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. Do not

offer the parts of your body to sin, as instruments of wickedness, but rather <u>offer yourselves</u> <u>to God</u>, as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer the parts of your body to him as instruments of righteousness. For sin shall not be your master, for you are not under

law, but under grace.

Luke 9:23-24 If anyone would come after me [Jesus], he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and

follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me

will save it.

<u>Abide in God</u> by deciding to remain a disciple (follower) to Jesus and choosing to obey his commands.

John 15:10 If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's

commands and remain in his love.

2 John 9 Anyone who runs ahead and does not continue in the teaching of Christ does not have God;

whoever continues in the teaching has both the Father and the Son.

1 John 2:6 Whoever claims to live in him must walk as Jesus did.

John 8:31-32 Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the

truth, and the truth will set you free."

James 1:22,25 Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. ...But the man

who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and <u>continues</u> to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it - he will be blessed in what he does. (Psalm 1)

<u>Prayer</u>: Speak with God through prayer every day to develop your relationship with God.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for

you in Christ Jesus.

Romans 12:12 Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, <u>faithful in prayer</u>.

John 15:7 If you remain in me [Jesus] and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will

be given you.

Ephesians 6:18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in

mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

<u>Read the Bible</u> regularly to further your understanding of God, to personally know Jesus Christ better and to guide you from being deceived.

Hebrews 4:12 For the <u>word of God is living and active</u>. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates

even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the

heart.

2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in

righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Romans 15:4 For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through endurance

and the encouragement of the Scriptures, we might have hope.

Acts 17:11 ..., for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day

to see if what Paul said was true.

<u>Find a congregation</u> where the Bible is deemed as the infallible and inerrant Word of God and as the absolute and final authority. Seek to find a credible fellowship of Christians that daily encourage each other toward righteousness (doing what is right) as accountable disciples.

Hebrews 3:12-13 See to it, brothers, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the

living God. But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of

you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.

Hebrews 10:24-25 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not

give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another -

and all the more as you see the Day coming.

John 13:34-35 A new commandment I give you: <u>Love one another</u>. As I [Jesus] have loved you, so you

must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one

another.

Matthew 28:19-20 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and

of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded

Be baptized in accordance with the instructions from Jesus.

Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of Acts 2:38

your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

1 Peter 3:21 ...were saved through water, and this water symbolizes baptism that now saves you also - not

the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a good conscience toward God.

Romans 6:3-4 Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his

> death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and Matthew 28:19

of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

Express gratitude joyfully by thanking God with respectful worship and honourable praise.

1 Chronicles 16:8-9 Give thanks to the Lord, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done.

Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 ...give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 2:6-7 ...continue to live in him [Jesus], rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you

were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

(Psalm 100:4, Psalm 95:1-2)

Matthew 4:10 Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.

Psalm 96.9 Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness; tremble before him, all the earth.

What is the Disciple's Authority: the Word of God, Prophecy or Understanding?

The Word of God

1 Corinthians 14:1 eagerly desire spiritual gifts, especially the gift of prophecy 1 Corinthians 14:39 be eager to prophesy 1 Thessalonians 5:19-22 do not treat prophecies with contempt 1 Corinthians 14:29-33 2 or 3 prophets should speak, weigh carefully what is said, prophesy in turn so that everyone may be instructed and encouraged 1 Corinthians 14:24-25 prophesying will lay the heart bare and convince an unbeliever that he is a sinner so he will worship God in the last days, sons + daughters + men + women will prophesy Acts 2:17-18 1 Corinthians 13:2 the gift of prophecy without love = nothing Deutronomy 13:1-4 if a false prophet announces a sign/wonder which also takes place, do not listen to him, God is testing you 1 Kings 13:1-32 an old prophet lied about the word of the Lord to the man of God, who was deceived and defied the word of the Lord prophesying lies in the name of the Lord, the Lord has not sent them Jeremiah 27:14-15 Jeremiah 29:31-32 prophesied without being sent and led you to believe a lie Jeremiah 14:14-16 prophets are prophesying lies in my name: false visions, divinations, idolatries, delusions of their own minds Jeremiah 23:16-32 do not listen to the prophets: false hopes, visions from their own minds, delusions, false dreams, lead my people astray with reckless lies Ezekiel 13:17 prophesy out of their own imagination 1 John 4:1 test the spirits, many false prophets have gone out into the world false prophets will introduce destructive heresies and many will follow their shameful ways 2 Peter 2:1-3 Matthew 7:15-23 watch out for false prophets; by their fruit you will recognize them, -prophesy in your name, drive out demons, perform miracles - but are evildoers Matthew 24:11 many false prophets will appear and deceive many people Matthew 24:24 false prophets will appear and perform great signs and miracles to deceive even the elect 2 Thessalonians 2:3-12 (4) the man of lawlessness sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God

(9) the coming of the lawless one will be displayed in counterfeit miracles, signs and wonders

(11) God sends them a powerful delusion so that they will believe the lie

Understanding & Wisdom

2 Timothy 4:7-8	fought the good fight/finished the race/kept the faith = crown of righteousness
Philippians 3:14	press on toward the goal to win the prize
1 Corinthians 9:24-27	run in such a way as to get the prize = go into strict training, do not run aimlessly, beat your body and make it your slave
2 Timothy 2:3-5	endure hardship like a good soldier, compete according to the rules = victor's crown
Philippians 1:29-30	granted on behalf of Christ: to believe & to suffer
Philippians 2:12-13	continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling
Luke 13:24	make every effort to enter through the narrow door
Revelations 2:10	faithful to the point of death = the crown of life
James 1:12	perseveres under trial + has stood the test = the crown of life
James 1:2-4	the testing of your faith develops perseverance
Romans 12:11-12	be joyful in hope + be patient in affliction
Romans 5:3-5	rejoice in suffering: suffering produces perseverance; character; and character, hope
Hebrews 10:35-39	(35) do not throw away your confidence

Romans 15:20 preached the gospel where Christ was not known

Acts 5:42 day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, the apostles never stopped
