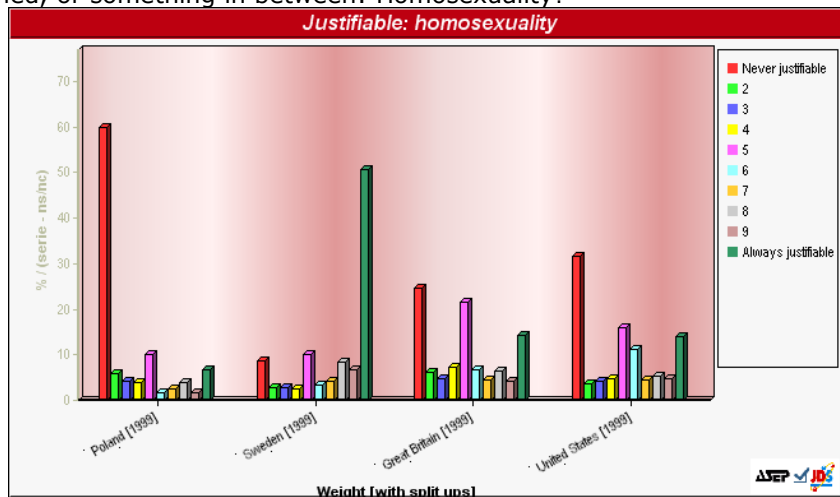
Please tell me for each of the following statements whether you think it can always be justified, never be justified, or something in between: Abortion?



Please tell me for each of the following statements whether you think it can always be justified, never be justified, or something in between: Divorce?

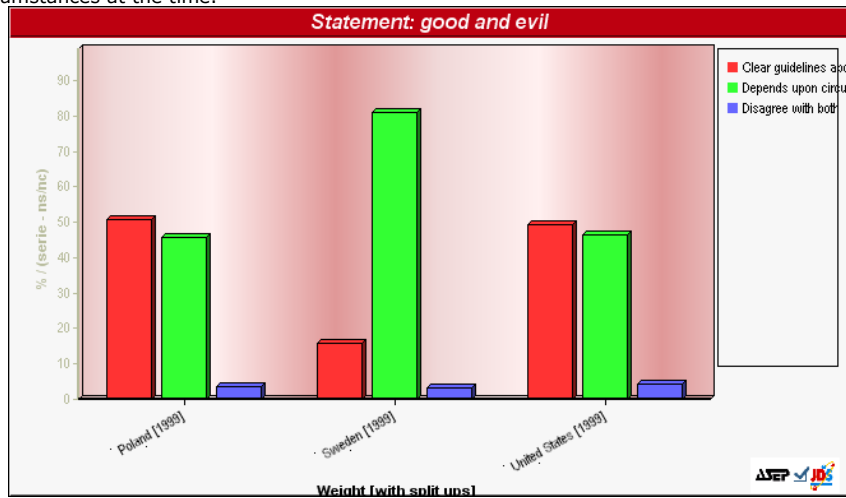


Please tell me for each of the following statements whether you think it can always be justified, never be justified, or something in between: Homosexuality?

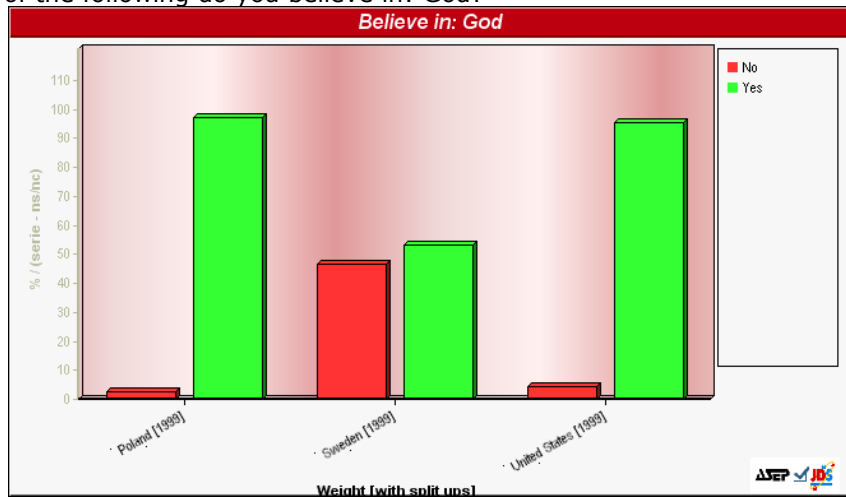


Here are two statements which people sometimes make when discussing good and evil. Which one comes closest to your own point of view?

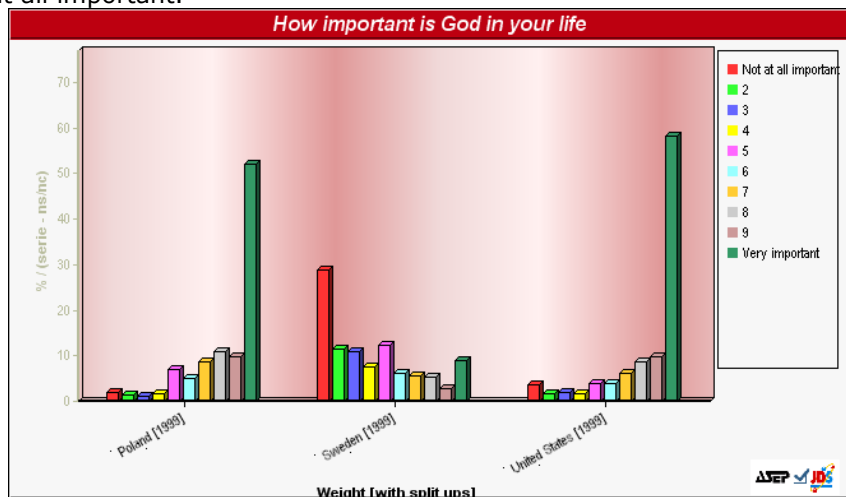
- A. There are absolutely clear guidelines about what is good and evil. These always apply to everyone, whatever the circumstances.
- B. There can never be absolutely clear guidelines about what is good and evil. What is good and evil depends entirely upon the circumstances at the time.



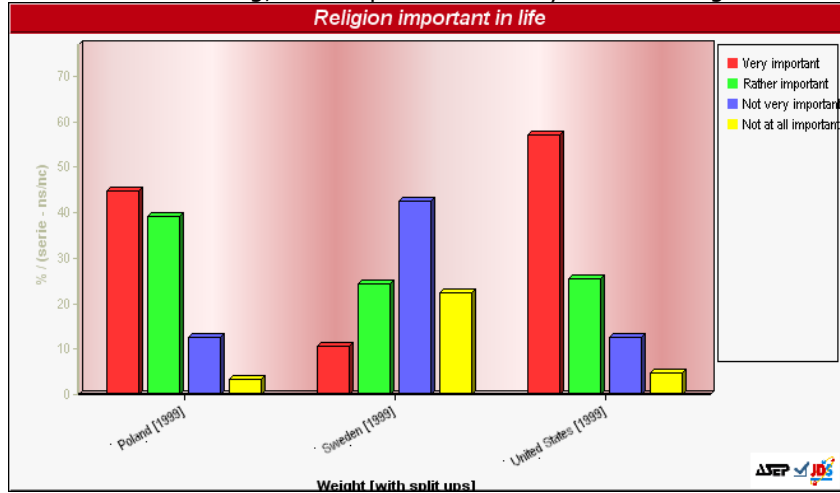
Which, if any, of the following do you believe in: God?



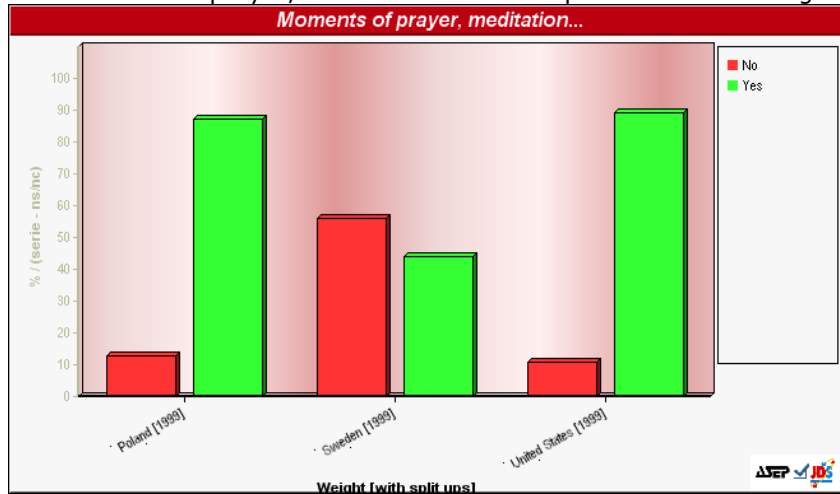
How important is God in your life? Please use this scale to indicate- 10 means very important and 1 means not at all important.



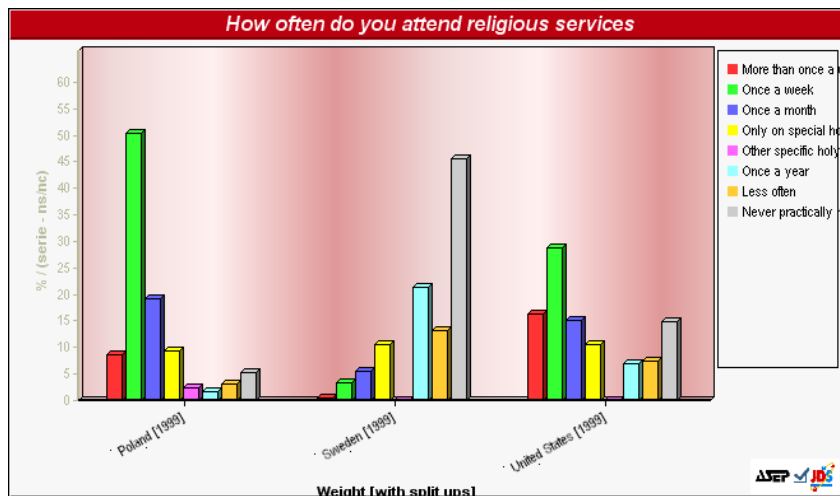
Please say, for each of the following, how important it is in your life: Religion?



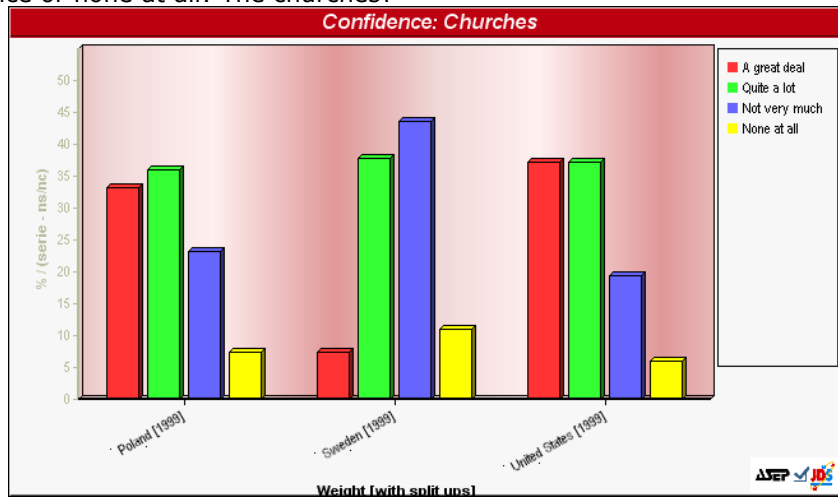
Do you take some moments of prayer, meditation or contemplation or something like that?



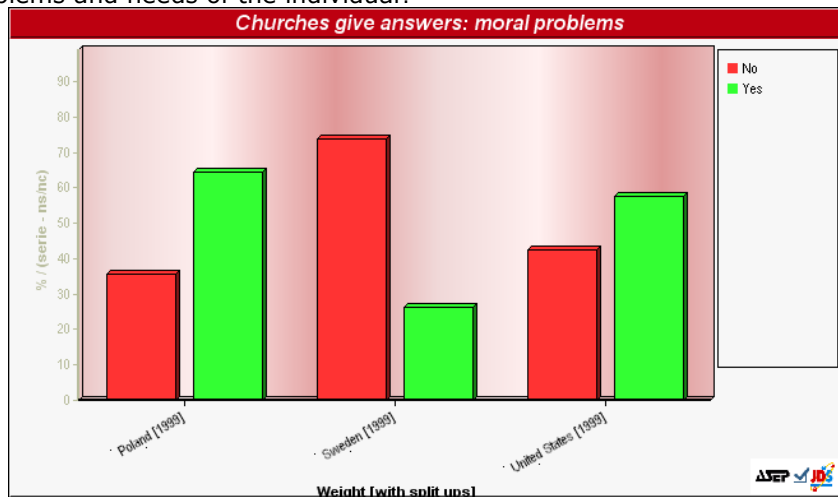
Apart from weddings, funerals and christenings, about how often do you attend religious services these days?
